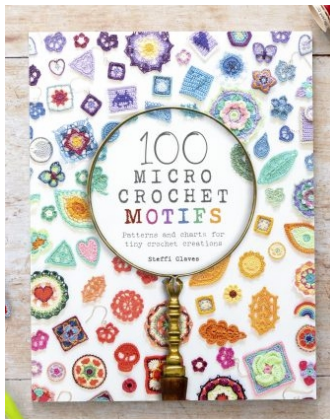

Micro crochet jewellery classes

Button Bracelet

Not sure if micro crochet is for you? Try this bracelet - incorporating buttons is not just fun and pretty, it makes the work easier to see, grip and crochet onto.

Skill level: confident beginner. Competence in basic crochet stitches will be required, such as double and half-treble crochet (UK terms).

Duration: 3 hours



Beaded Ivy Bracelet

This ivy bracelet is a great introduction to incorporating beads in a simple and dainty way to your jewellery. All materials are provided, including a 0.9mm hook, threads and jewellery findings.

Skill level: confidence in beginners crochet. Competence in basic crochet stitches will be required, such as double and treble crochet (UK terms).

Duration: 3 hours



Granny Square Earrings

In this session you will be making granny squares for jewellery while also conquering the magic ring and thread ends in colour-changes. You'll work with sterling silver findings and a 0.9mm hook, with the option to go smaller or larger to suit your style.

Skill level: intermediate in regular crochet. Confidence in basic crochet stitches will be required, such as double and treble crochet (UK terms).

Duration: 3 hours



Regular yarn crochet classes

Beginner's crochet

In this session, you will be introduced to the basic stitches that are the foundation of any crocheted item. from chain stitch to treble crochet stitch. You will get to know these stitches through making a little rectangular sample working in rows, alongside understanding how to hold your hook and yarn for comfortable and consistent crochet stitches.

Duration: 3 hours (can be extended to 4-5 hours).

Skill level: complete beginner, never seen a crochet hook before.

Yarn used: DK cotton and 3mm hook (bigger/thicker options available)



layered flower brooch

This is the easier-than-it-looks flower brooch that is suitable for beginners. In this project you will conquer the magic ring and use basic crochet stitches to create a flower with pretty layered petals.

You will be using a 3mm hook and DK cotton, which will be provided in this class, along with brooch backs and buttons. Stitches used in this project are chains, slip stitches, double crochet and treble crochet (UK terms).

Duration: 3 hours.

Skill level: confident beginner, competence in holding your hook and yarn, double crochet and treble crochet will be needed or this session.

Yarn used: DK yarn, 3mm hook.

Class and material costs

Please refer to the workshop table for tutor fees. Materials are charged separately at £4-£5 per participant and include all items required to complete the workshop, unless otherwise agreed. If the venue prefers to supply certain materials (for example, yarn for the Complete Beginners Crochet workshop), the materials charge can be adjusted accordingly.

Travel
